

- Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odorless gas produced by incomplete combustion of fuels such as natural and LP gas, kerosene, coal, wood and charcoal. Any fuel burning device, including appliances, automobiles, and fireplaces can produce CO.
- Exposure to CO can cause fatigue, chest pains, impaired vision and coordination, headaches, dizziness, confusion, nausea and, can even be fatal.
- Every year, there are more than 2,000 fatalities in the United States from CO produced by improperly installed or maintained fuel-burning appliances.
- Carrier recommends placing a Carbon Monoxide Alarm on each level of the house and in every bedroom.



- Carrier recommends checking the alarm weekly and having it professionally inspected on an annual basis.

- 1 **Continuous digital display** - lets you monitor the level of CO currently in your home. Display is updated every 15 seconds.
- 2 **Test / Reset button** - checks the unit's electronic circuitry and horn. Resets the unit during alarm.
- 3 **Peak level button** - displays the highest CO level recorded since the alarm was last reset or unplugged.
- 4 **AC plug adapter** - provides constant power to the unit and allows flexibility of placement: direct plug-in, wall-mounted or tabletop.
- 5 **Rechargeable lithium ion battery** - provides uninterrupted protection even during a power outage.
